Prairie Conservation and Endangered Species Conference: Early bird registration open now!

October 6, 2025 - Saskatoon, Sask.

Early-bird registration is now open for the 14th Prairie Conservation and Endangered Species Conference to be held in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan from May 5-7, 2026. This important event will provide a meeting ground for a variety of professionals with a shared interest in prairie conservation and protection, including researchers, consultants, Indigenous groups, non-government organizations, federal and provincial environment and natural resource staff, as well as ranching and community-based organizations. This event has been held every three years for over three decades and highlights a diverse collaboration of projects, research, and conservation efforts from Alberta, Saskatchewan and Manitoba.

The 2026 conference theme, “Diversity: Key to Resilience”, recognizes the importance of diversity, from the ecosystems we strive to protect, to those working together to protect them. This conference illustrates the strength in diversity and collaboration for continued success with prairie conservation and endangered species management.

In addition to the opening of registration, the conference will begin accepting abstract submissions at this time. Abstracts are welcomed from anyone interested in contributing oral presentations, posters, or workshops that align with the conference’s themes.

In addition to plenary and break-out presentations, the Prairie Conservation and Endangered Species Conference also includes a reception, banquet, tradeshow and poster session highlighting innovative prairie and species at risk research, conservation practices and initiatives. 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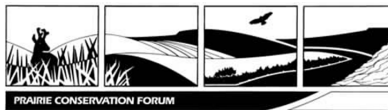
